

EONZ Facilitator Pool: Call for Expressions of Interest.

Expressions of Interest are invited by suitable candidates to join the EONZ facilitation team in one or both of two key current areas of delivery:

- EOTC Management PLD, comprising the 1 and 2-day PLD
- PLD within contexts of Revisioning School Camps

This is both a professional and personal development opportunity for registered teachers who are looking to expand their practice and take on leadership within EOTC networks, and who are committed to the kaupapa of EONZ.

The training

- Involves a training period that includes at least one Zoom meeting, before moving to workshop observation and progressive facilitation responsibilities in a supported workshop environment. The training will commence in Term 2 2021.
- Requires availability to attend up to 4 full day workshops during school hours in the remainder of 2021.
- Teacher release days (or the equivalent if not working in a school) will be paid for.
- Involves working under and with support from lead facilitators for the remainder of 2021.

There is an expectation that some of your own time is spent reading and understanding PLD content. This continues as you move into a role as a full member of the facilitation team.

The facilitation position

- Involves the preparation and delivery of full day workshops following a set delivery plan for each specific set of PLD. There are two types of EOTC Management PLD. One is delivered over 2 separate days, generally no more than a month separating each day. The second is a one day workshop. The Revisioning School Camps PLD involves a one day workshop and post-workshop engagement with participants that includes a ½ day wānanga revisit.
- Requires experience in peer to peer facilitation, with the ability to work with leadership groups in school settings an advantage
- Requires facilitators to be engaged in their own professional learning and critical thinkers of different pedagogies
- Requires facilitators to uphold <u>Our Code Our Standards Code of Professional Responsibility</u> and Standards for the Teaching Profession, Ngā Tikanga Matatika Ngā Paerewa

The positions are part time in nature with dates set to accommodate facilitator availability, the most work occurring in a defined period during each year. Terms 2 and 3 are generally target terms.

There is an expectation that a facilitator would be available to deliver between 2 to 4 sets of PLD in a year.

The steps from here:

- 1. Submit an EOI by emailing office@eonz.org.nz and requesting:
 - the appropriate Position Description
 - a link to the full application form
- 2. Applications close at 5pm FRIDAY MAY 7
- 3. Applicants may be asked for an interview. Notification of successful applications will be made approximately 2 weeks following the close of applications.
- 4. Successful applicants will enter into an independent contractor agreement
